Section 1: Almanac

Comprised of 10 major categories, including history, geography, science, awards & regulations, economics, vital statistics and more! Readers will find articles, color maps and photographs, charts and tables for a fact-filled snapshot of Canada. This section is valuable for residents, politicians, and the business community!

Section 2: Arts & Culture

Includes 9 categories: art galleries, aquaria, botanical gardens, museums, observatories, national parks, performing arts, science centres, and zoos. All categories are arranged by province and city and each listing includes important contact information such as: address, phone, fax, website, email, key executives and a brief description.

Section 3: Associations

Lists thousands of associations and organizations arranged in 113 topics from accounting to writers. Each listing includes valuable descriptions and current contact information. The Association Name Index precedes the listings.

Section 4: Broadcasting

This section begins with Canada's major broadcasting companies, then lists, by province, all radio and television stations, as well as cable companies and specialty broadcasters.

Section 5: Business & Finance

This section begins with Canada's major broadcasting companies, then lists, by province, all radio and television stations, as well as cable companies and specialty broadcasters.

Section 6: Education

Arranged by province, this section includes government agencies, districts, specialized and independent schools, university and technical facilities, and most listings have a valuable description.

Section 7: Federal Government

This section begins with a Quick Reference Guide to help you find your way around government agencies. The guide is followed by federal and provincial listings, plus information on The Royal Family and foreign diplomatic representation.

Section 8: Municipal Government

All county and municipal districts and segregated major municipalities are highlighted in this section. Each profile includes date of incorporation, square miles, and population figures as well as district maps for all provinces.

Section 9: Judicial Government

This section provides thorough coverage for courts in Canada, including federal and provincial. Listings are categorized by type of court and city within each province, and include presiding judges.

Section 10: Hospitals & Health Care Facilities

An overview of available facilities by province Government agencies, hospitals, community health centres, retirement care and mental health facilities are all arranged alphabetically by city for easy access.

Section 11: Law Firms

Includes a separate section of Major law Firms with descriptions and Senior Partners. Following this are law firms arranged by province.

Section 12: Libraries

This section begins with Canada's main Library/Archive and Government Departments for Libraries. Followed by provincial listings with Regional Systems listed first and Public Libraries and Archives listed second.

Section 13: Publishing

Includes publishers of books, magazines, newspapers as well as a list of newspapers by province. Magazine listings are arranged in six major categories, preceded by a magazine index for easy searching. Details include frequency and circulation figures.

Section 14: Religion

Starts with broad information on religious groups, then lists associations, arranged alphabetically by 18 denominations ranging from Anglican to United Church of Christ.

Section 15: Sports

Provides associations for 88 single sports, plus detailed league and team listings for baseball, basketball, football, hockey, lacrosse and soccer. You'll also find the major sports venues in Canada.

Section 16: Transportation

Offers comprehensive listings for major transportation modes, plus industry associations, government agencies and port authorities.

Section 17: Utilities

Includes associations, government agencies and provincial utility companies.
