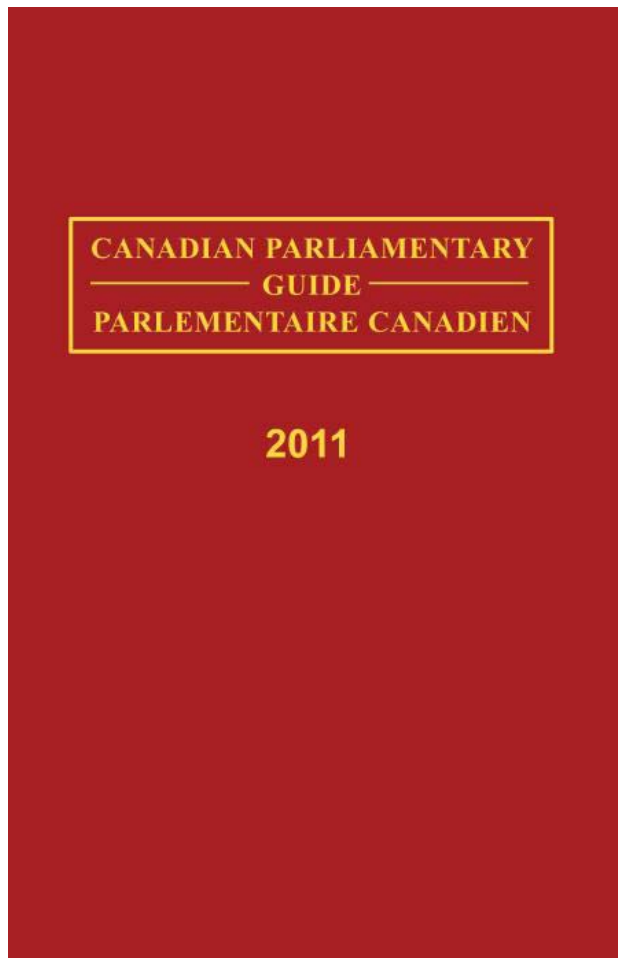


CANADIAN PARLIAMENTARY GUIDE

THE CANADIAN PARLIAMENTARY GUIDE IS BROKEN DOWN INTO 5 COMPREHENSIVE CATEGORIES:

Monarchy

- biographical information on Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, The Royal Family and the Governor General

Federal Government

- a separate chapter for each, Privy Council, Senate, House of Commons including a brief description of the institution, its history in both text and chart format and a list of current members, followed by un-paralleled biographical sketches*

General Elections – separated into 2 categories

1867 – 2006

- information is listed alphabetically by province then by riding name
- notes on each riding include: date of establishment, date of abolition, former division, later divisions etc. followed by election year and successful candidate's name and party
- by-election information follows

2008

- information for the 2008 election is organized in the same manner but also includes information of all the candidates who ran in each riding, their party affiliation and the number of votes won

Courts: Federal

Each court chapter includes:

- a description of the court (Supreme, Federal, Federal Court of appeal, Court Martial Appeal, Tax Court)
- a synopsis of each court's history
- a list of its judges, followed by a biographical sketch of each judge

Provincial and Territorial Governments

Each provincial chapter includes:

- a list of current cabinet members
- biographical sketches of all members
- general election and by-election results
- statistical information
- a list of current members and constituencies
- a description of Legislative Assembly
- dates of legislatures since Confederation
- biographical sketch of the Lieutenant Governor

Biographical Sketches - are compiled using data from a variety of sources.

All Biographies in this edition are current, and include the following information:

- Personal: date of birth, education and family
- Political Career: public career of office held
- Private Career: work history outside of politics
- Address: Legislative office, Constituency office and home if available
