Addison's Disease

Addison's disease, also referred to as adrenal insufficiency, stems from the malfunction of the adrenal glands located on top of the kidneys. In this disease, there is an insufficient amount of cortisol and aldosterone produced by the adrenal cortex, the gland's firm outer layer.

Cause

Most often, Addison's disease results from destruction of the adrenal gland. Patients develop antibodies against their own adrenal tissue (autoimmune reaction). It may also be caused by fungal infections (or other infections such as HIV and tuberculosis), malignant tumours, trauma or blood loss.

Symptoms

The symptoms of Addison's disease usually develop over the course of several months. Signs of the disease include fatigue, weakness, loss of appetite, nausea and vomiting, low blood pressure (hypotension) and salt cravings. Other symptoms such as darkening of the skin (hyperpigmentation), low blood sugar (hypoglycemia), depression and irritability may also occur. If a person is in acute adrenal failure (Addisonian crisis), there may be a sudden onset of signs and symptoms such as severe vomiting and diarrhea, pain in the lower back or legs, low blood pressure, difficulty breathing and loss of consciousness.

Prevalence

Addison's disease is a rare disorder that is diagnosed in 100,000 people. It affects men, women and children.
